The center can take charge of children 9:00 to 12:00, it costs 45 dollars to 60 dollars, three days or two days in a week. The he rate is fixed by the number of times to go to the playcenter. As for 3 years old or more, 20 hour childcare charges are free in the New Zealand each month. The number of children is different every day, but is from eight to ten children.
